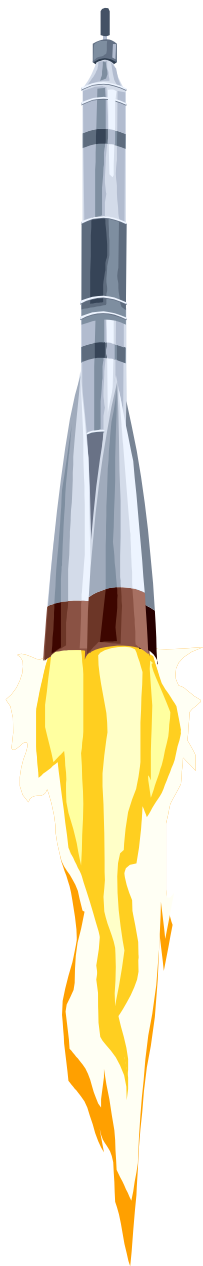


Advanced High Power & Model Rocket Launches !

- When:** First Sunday of each month from March to September 2005, 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Where:** **Monroe Launch Facility** near Monroe, 37 miles NE of Seattle
- Who:** Come one, come all! This launch is sponsored by National Association of Rocketry (NAR) Section 627

Open to the public and free-of-charge on launch days, the Monroe Launch Facility is a fabulous grassy site spanning 550 acres. Flights are made in accordance with all applicable regulations including FAA, BATFE, NFPA Codes 1122 & 1127 and the federal Homeland Security and Safe Explosives Acts. Parking is available adjacent to the launch site on the gravel access road. However, parking is *not* allowed on the field itself due to buried irrigation equipment. The site has an FAA launch waiver which allows for rockets weighing up to 20 pounds to fly as high as 5,000 feet. Launch control systems, launch pads & safety personnel are provided by the sponsoring group, NAR Section 627. Bring your big birds and your model rockets, or just come and hang out. Whether 5 or 85 years old, whether simply curious or highly experienced, you are sure to enjoy a family-oriented good time! ***Please note:*** For both insurance and safety reasons, absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal substances can be allowed on site. ***Questions?*** Contact Dave Davis at the above coordinates, or visit www.BEMRC.org

Directions – From King County and points South:

- Take I-405 North to Exit #23 (Hwy 522 / Woodinville)
- Go to the end of 522 East, where it meets Hwy 2 in Monroe
- Turn Left (East) on Hwy 2 & proceed to the 2nd stop light.
- At the light, turn Right (South) on Lewis St. (Hwy 203)
- Go 3.4 miles to 203rd St. (at Dept of Corrections sign)
- Turn Right & go 0.3 miles to the first stop sign
- Turn Left & go 0.4 miles. The launch site is on your left
- Turn sharp left onto the gravel access road. You've arrived!

Directions – From Snohomish County and points North:

- Take I-5 to Exit #194 (Hwy 2)
- Go East 15.2 miles on Hwy 2 until the town of Monroe
- Pass the Hwy 522 overpass & proceed to 3rd stop light
- At the light, turn Right (South) on Lewis St. (Hwy 203)
- Go 3.4 miles to 203rd St. (at Dept of Corrections sign)
- Turn Right & go 0.3 miles to the first stop sign
- Turn Left & go 0.4 miles. The launch site is on your left
- Turn sharp left onto the gravel access road. You've arrived!
